Anysize Steeplechase will consist of jumps and tunnels (no other equipment will be used). Jump heights will be: 450mm, 350mm and 250mm (handler's choice) with combined results.

GRADE CHANGES

If you entered the show online via Agility Plaza and the show has not yet closed then please change your grade online 14 days before the show. Under KC rules grades/jump heights cannot be changed on the day. If you sent a postal entry, please advise Agility Plaza as soon as possible email: support@agilityplaza.com.

Eligibility for Classes

In the following definitions of classes First prize or other prize wins are those gained in standard classes at any Kennel Club licensed Championship agility, Premier agility, Open agility or Limited agility Shows (i.e. special classes and invitational events are excepted). Standard classes may be scheduled for Agility Shows, as Agility classes or Jumping classes. All standard classes must contain the Weaving Poles obstacle. Standard Agility classes must contain the following elements: "A Ramp", Dog Walk and See-Saw.

Class Structure

A Class may either be held as a Graded Class or a Combined Class. A Graded Class may be scheduled for a maximum of three consecutive Grades with separate results and awards issued for each grade. The eligibility for a Graded Class is detailed below. A Combined Class may be scheduled for more than one consecutive grade with one overall set of results. A Combined Class is open to any combination of dog and handler that qualifies for any of the Grades in that class.

Progression

Progression from each Grade will be determined by the eligibility for the class as referenced in H (1)(A)11. Results from Combined Classes will only count towards progression from the dog's current grade. To count for progression wins must be gained in standard classes at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows. Only a first place with a clear round completed within the course time set by the judge will count towards grade progression.

Lower Height Option

Societies may offer the Lower Height Option to all dogs in that height category and may be offered at all grades. It is to be run as part of any Standard class as defined in the regulations and must be clearly identified in the schedule. Each relevant class will have two heights with a change part way through to raise/lower the jump heights and may extend/reduce the length of the long jump and width of the rising spread, within the permitted ranges, and competitors must run at their entered height. The order in which the heights will run must be detailed on the ring cards/ring plan. There will be only one course walking at the start of the class. In a class where the Lower Height Option is available show organisers may offer one set of awards by combining the results of each height or may offer separate awards for each height category.

When the Lower Height Option is scheduled a dog may only be entered at either the Full Height or at the Lower Height and it cannot compete at a different height in any other class at that competition, including special classes. For these purposes a competition shall be defined as all classes covered within the same schedule.

Points Progression

At the handler's discretion a dog may progress up to Grade 4 by winning 100 points at each grade, using the Agility Warrant point's scheme (Regulation K3.c refers). A minimum of 50 points must be gained in agility (not jumping) classes in the relevant grade. If this method of progression is selected, the handler must ensure the Show Secretary signs the dog's Agility Record Book at the first show entered at the higher grade. There is no time limit on this progression, however once a dog has progressed, it cannot return to a previous grade. Progression on points must be done prior to the closing date of entries. It is not possible to change a grade on points once the entries have closed.

Standard Classes

Only first prizes and points gained in standard classes at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows may be used for progression through the classes. (A dog is only eligible for one grade). In defining the eligibility of the owner or handler for Grade 1, the two wins and points progression referred to in the definition apply only to one dog and not an accumulation of dogs.

Grade 1: Open to owners, handlers or dogs which have not gained a minimum of two first places at Grade 1 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, at least one of which must have been gained in an agility (not jumping) class. N.B Owners, handlers or dogs previously qualified out of Grade 1 are not eligible for this class.

Grade 2: Open to dogs which are not eligible for Grade 1 or have elected to progress on points from Grade 1 and are not eligible for Grades 3, 4, 5, 6, or 7.

Grade 3: Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of two first places at Grade 2 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, one of which must have been gained in an agility (not jumping) class, or have elected to progress on points from Grade 2 and are not eligible for Grades 2, 4, 5, 6 or 7.

Grade 4: Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of three first places at Grade 3 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, two of which must have been gained in agility (not jumping classes), or have elected to progress on points from Grade 3 and are not eligible for Grades 2, 3, 5, 6 or 7.

Grade 5: Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of four first places at Grade 4 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, two of which must have been gained in agility (not jumping) classes, and are not eligible for Grades 2, 3, 4, 6 or 7.

Grade 6: Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of four first places at Grade 5 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, two of which must have been gained in agility (not jumping) classes, and are not eligible for Grades 2, 3, 4, 5 or 7.

Grade 7: Open to dogs which have gained a minimum of five first places at Grade 6 at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows, three of which must have been gained in agility (not jumping) classes, and are not eligible for Grades 2, 3, 4, 5 or 6.

Anysize: Open to dogs not entered in any standard class at the show. Standard KC marking will apply. Heights will be set at Micro, Small & Medium. You may choose on the day the height you wish to compete at. Courses will only include jumps and tunnels and will be flowing. Rosettes & Prizes sponsored by EmPaws.

PRIZES AND AWARDS – STANDARD CLASSES

Trophies

1 > 30 dogs = 1st place

31 > 75 = 2nd place

76 + 3rd place

Rosettes will be awarded to at least 10% of the entry.

Combined classes are counted by the total in the class and Graded classes are counted by the total in each Grade and then split into LH & FH

ALL AWARDS MUST BE COLLECTED AT THE SHOW

It is impossible to run a show without asking for extra help. If you can help, please indicate this on the entry form. Priority parking and refreshments for anyone who can help and if you help for ½ day or more lunch & afternoon cake will be also be provided. The approach into Hunters Race and the venue from the A286 is over a very narrow blind humpback bridge with weight restrictions. This route is fine for cars and vans, but DO NOT USE this route with caravans or motor homes.

To avoid the narrow bridge use the darker blue route as shown on map below.

There are no suitable pull ins to pass for larger vehicles, we would strongly recommend that you follow the advised route and suggest you use the 'VIA' Fishbourne option when setting your SAT NAV.

This will avoid the Chichester route.

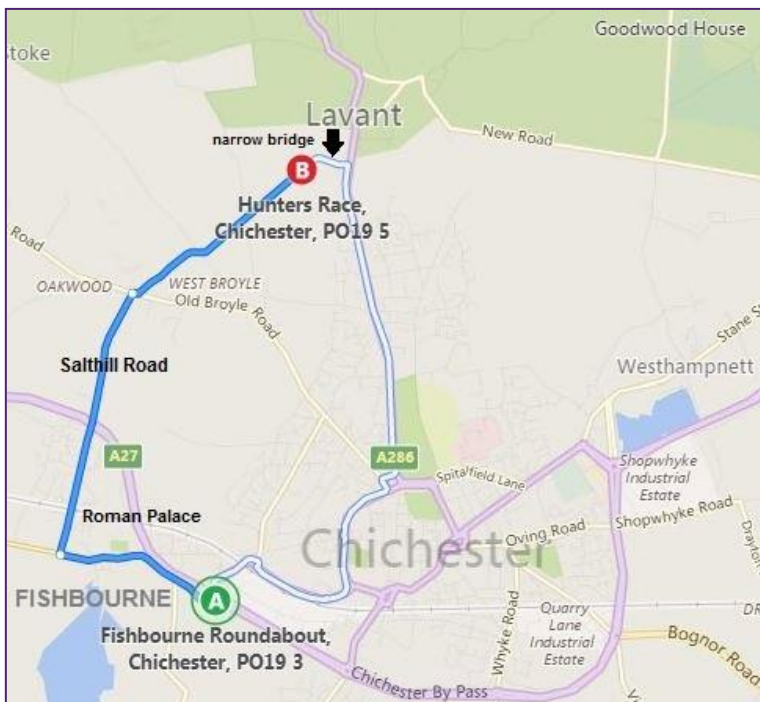
From the WEST:

Follow the A27 until it's junction with A259, then take the 4th exit sign posted Fishbourne. After 0.9 miles, turn right at the turning BROWN signpost for Fishbourne Roman Palace, (Salthill Road).

Follow this road (Ignore next sign for Palace) for 1.3 miles to the T-Junction, turn right, then immediately turn left (staggered junction) this is Hunters Race continue to venue.

From the EAST:

For Caravans and Motorhomes you would be advised to use the above route from Fishbourne.



FOR CARS/VANS

From Midhurst, (the venue is 10 miles south) follow the A286 towards Chichester, once through Lavant, the turning for Hunters Race is on the right, 0.2 miles after the Pook Lane mini roundabout.

The venue is just over the narrow bridge on the left.

From Chichester, (the venue is 3 miles north): follow the signs to Midhurst and for the A286, once on this road follow towards Lavant and the turning for Hunters Race is on the left, 0.3 miles after the Esso Garage.

The venue is just over the narrow bridge on the left.

Camping - preference will be given to those offering ½ day+ help. Spaces will also be reserved for postal entries. Please camp as directed & keep within the pitch marks.

Units should be equipped with own fire extinguishers or a bucket of water at the front of the unit.

There are no showers at this venue. NO BBQ's allowed.

Camping arrivals accepted from 2.30pm on Thursday

If you have not arranged early arrival you will be put in a holding area until pitches are ready.

Early arrivals accepted from people offering to set up the rings by pre arrangement ONLY.

Rules and Regulations

1. Dogs entered at Kennel Club Licensed Agility Shows must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club regulations for classification and registration B or else registration or transfer of registration must have been applied for. The registration number/authority to compete (ATC) number will be required for each entry.
2. Entry fees: £3.60 per dog per class.
3. All postal entries to be sent to The Agility Plaza c/o The Bungalow, Lockengate, St Austell PL26 8RY. Plaza entry enquiries to support@agilityplaza.com. Please add £2.00 for paper administration and running orders to be posted. Do NOT send SAE. Internet entries via www.agilityplaza.com will be accepted and all running orders for online entries will be e-mailed to you or can be downloaded directly from the site.
4. The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
5. Only dogs of 18 calendar months of age and over on the day of competition are eligible for competition at Kennel Club licensed Agility Shows.
6. A dog must not compete in the same class more than once, including special classes.
7. Not for Competition entries will be accepted for dogs aged four calendar months and over. Dogs must be Kennel Club registered with their details recorded on the entry form.
8. No bitch in season is allowed to compete and the mating of bitches within the precincts of the competition is forbidden.
9. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the Show.
10. Dogs must not wear any type of slip, half-slip collar or lead when under test. A single flat, close fitting collar is permitted, providing the only attachment is a plain identification panel as an integral part of the collar i.e. not attached by a ring.
11. Should a judge be unable to fulfil their appointment the Committee reserves the right to appoint another Judge.
12. No competitor shall impugn the decision of the judge or judges.
13. There is no sponsorship or prize money.
14. KC Regulation Standard Marking will apply for all standard classes.
15. All small and medium dogs must have been measured officially before competing at the show.
The height limit for dogs in standard classes is:
 - a) Large Dogs – For dogs measuring over 430mm at the withers
 - b) Medium Dogs – For dogs measuring over 350mm and measuring 430mm or under at the withers
 - c) Small Dogs – For dogs measuring 350mm or under at the withers.
16. Judges at an Agility Show may not enter for competition a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership or handle a dog at the Show at which they are judging. Dogs may be disqualified if proved to have been handled in the class by the scheduled judge's spouse or immediate family, or resident at the same address as the scheduled judge.
17. Removal of dogs from Competition:
Following discussion between the show management and/or a veterinary surgeon, a dog shall be prevented from competing and/or removed from the show if it is:-
 - a) A bitch which is in season, b) Suffering from any infectious or contagious disease, c) Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent, d) Of such temperament or is so much out of control as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal, e) Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.The circumstances of such a removal shall be recorded in the competition/show Incident Book and submitted to the Kennel Club.
18. In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including 25 days before the start of the competition shall be counted when entering for any classes **i.e. 5th August 2019**. For these purposes a competition shall be defined as all classes covered within the same schedule. In the event that a dog becomes eligible for the next grade at a particular show, after the entry for that show has been sent, it is the competitor's responsibility to notify the [show secretary at least 14 days before the date of the show](#). The dog will then be moved into the appropriate class(es) for the next grade. The dog must be moved into the corresponding number of classes as were entered at the lower grade. If there are fewer or no classes available for the next grade the competitor will be offered a refund of the relevant entry fees.
19. Should circumstances so dictate, the Club, in consultation with the judges, may alter arrangements as necessary - such changes and the circumstances surrounding them must be reported to the Kennel Club.
20. In the event that the show is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, Waverunners Agility will refund fees, less reasonably incurred expenses. If the show processor has the provisions to do so, the competitors will be refunded in the manner in which they had entered the show, but in any event, Waverunners will refund fees within 3 months of the show date to all those who had entered and requested a refund within 1 month of the show date.
21. Except for mobility aids, nothing shall be carried in the hand or while the dog is under test and food shall not be given to a dog whilst in the ring. Competitors are prohibited from wearing bags or leads whilst under test.
22. Should the judge deem a re-run is required, any results and/or faults gained in the previous run must be discounted.
23. Separate entry forms must be completed by each owner and must be signed by the owner or his authorised agent in accordance with the provisions specified thereon. Entry forms must be accompanied by the appropriate fees.
24. No practice is allowed on the course save that competitors will be allowed to walk the course set at Small, Medium or Large height without their dog(s) before the class begins. The height of the hurdles may be raised/lowered and the length of the long jump and width of the rising spread may be extended/reduced, within the permitted ranges, during the course walking time if multiple heights are offered within the same class.

25. Competition of Dogs suffering from Contagious or Infectious Disease – No dogs suffering from infectious or contagious disease or having been exposed to such disease during the period of 21 days prior to the Competition may compete. Competitors infringing the Regulation will be liable to be fined and/or dealt with under Kennel Club Rule A11.
26. It is the competitor's responsibility to be available for their Class and Running Order. Competitors must run as close to their running order as possible. Failure to do so may be reported to the Kennel Club.
27. No animal other than one officially entered shall be brought into the precincts of the event during its continuance, except any dogs registered to assist the disabled, or dogs required for educational or instructional purposes or by permission of the General Committee. However, at the discretion of the show society, a dog brought to the show by a spectator may be admitted into the precincts of the dog show, with the proviso that those in charge of the dog sign a declaration confirming the dog is free from disease and that the dog will be kept under proper control at all times.
28. All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete (ATC) number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without a Kennel Club Registration number or an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
29. A pay on the day class or practice ring may be held if time permits.
30. The height of the hurdles will be:
- a) 650mm (**550mm for Lower Height Option**) for Large Dogs,
 - b) 450mm (**350mm for Lower Height Option**) for Medium Dogs
 - c) and 350mm (**250mm for Lower Height Option**) for Small Dogs.
 - d) Width: 1.219m minimum.
31. Dog Agility is a competitive and physically strenuous activity. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to ensure their dog is 'fit for function' and that they themselves are fit to take part. By signing the entry form you confirm that to the best of your knowledge your dog is fit and able to take part in Agility classes on the day of the show.
32. If a dog should foul, handler or owner must clean it up as soon as possible.
33. Due to the number of classes, time limits may be set at the discretion of the Judge.
34. In the event of any cheque or money order not being honoured when first presented to the bank the exhibitor shall be held liable for any bank charges or fees incurred, If the entry fee and such charges are not paid immediately upon request the exhibitor will be reported to the Kennel Club and will be dealt with by the Kennel Club Committee.
35. In the event of a competitor having any complaint or concern they should raise this with the Judge, Ring Manager or Show Manager as appropriate whereupon it will be dealt with accordingly. Any inappropriate behaviour and/or abuse towards any member of the Ring Party and/or the Judge will not be tolerated. Any individual persisting in this behaviour will be asked to leave the show immediately.
36. For the purposes of show processing and scoring at the event, your details will be entered into a computer system and stored in accordance with GDPR. Show results will be published online at www.agilityplaza.com.
37. Welfare of dogs. An exhibitor (or competitor) whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this regulation may be referred to the Board for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. The use of pinch collars, electronic shock collars, or prong collars, is not permitted at any Agility show licensed by the Kennel Club. This shall apply at the venue and within the precincts of the show.
38. Rosettes & Prizes for Class 37 & 71 sponsored by EmPaws
39. Any owner, handler or person in charge of the dog is required to remove as soon as possible any fouling caused by their dog(s) within the venue. Anyone failing to remove fouling will be asked to leave the venue immediately.

Returned cheques will incur a £12.00 charge. Refunds for postal entries which have been processed before the closing date will be subject to a £2.00 processing & admin fee, no refunds given after the closing date.

Record books may be inspected at the request of the Judge or show management. All dogs entered at this show at the owners' risk. Whilst every care will be taken; the organisers will not accept responsibility for loss, damage or injury however caused to persons, dogs or property.

DOGS IN VEHICLES ON HOT DAYS: Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts travelling to and whilst at KC licensed events. When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.

If your vehicle is not air conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.

The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink. • Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog. When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.

Keep the dog in the shade – take your own shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog always stays well hydrated. Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time. Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.

WARNING: IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED.
